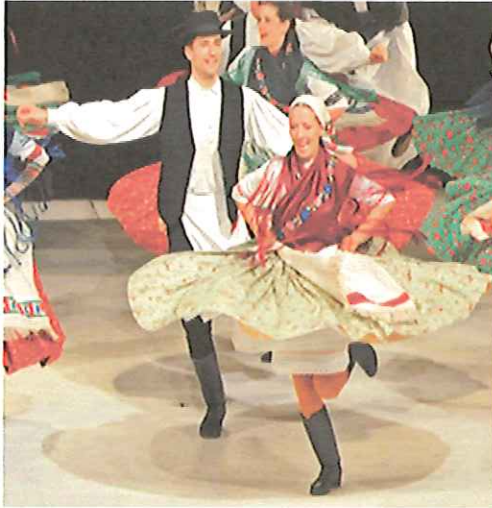

The 75th Anniversary Legacy Wall was dedicated in the lower gardens in 2013. Plaques of famous Hungarians with areas of expertise are displayed and includes the first use of internet RFID scan informational chips in any of the gardens. The gardens were originally formally dedicated to Franz Liszt in 1938 with his bas-relief plaque.
