The site of the Hungarian Cultural Garden was dedicated October 21, 1934, on the 123rd anniversary of the birth of Ferenc Liszt, with the unveiling of the bas-relief plaque of the world famous Hungarian composer. **The Garden was completed and formally dedicated on July 10, 1938, 80 years ago.**
